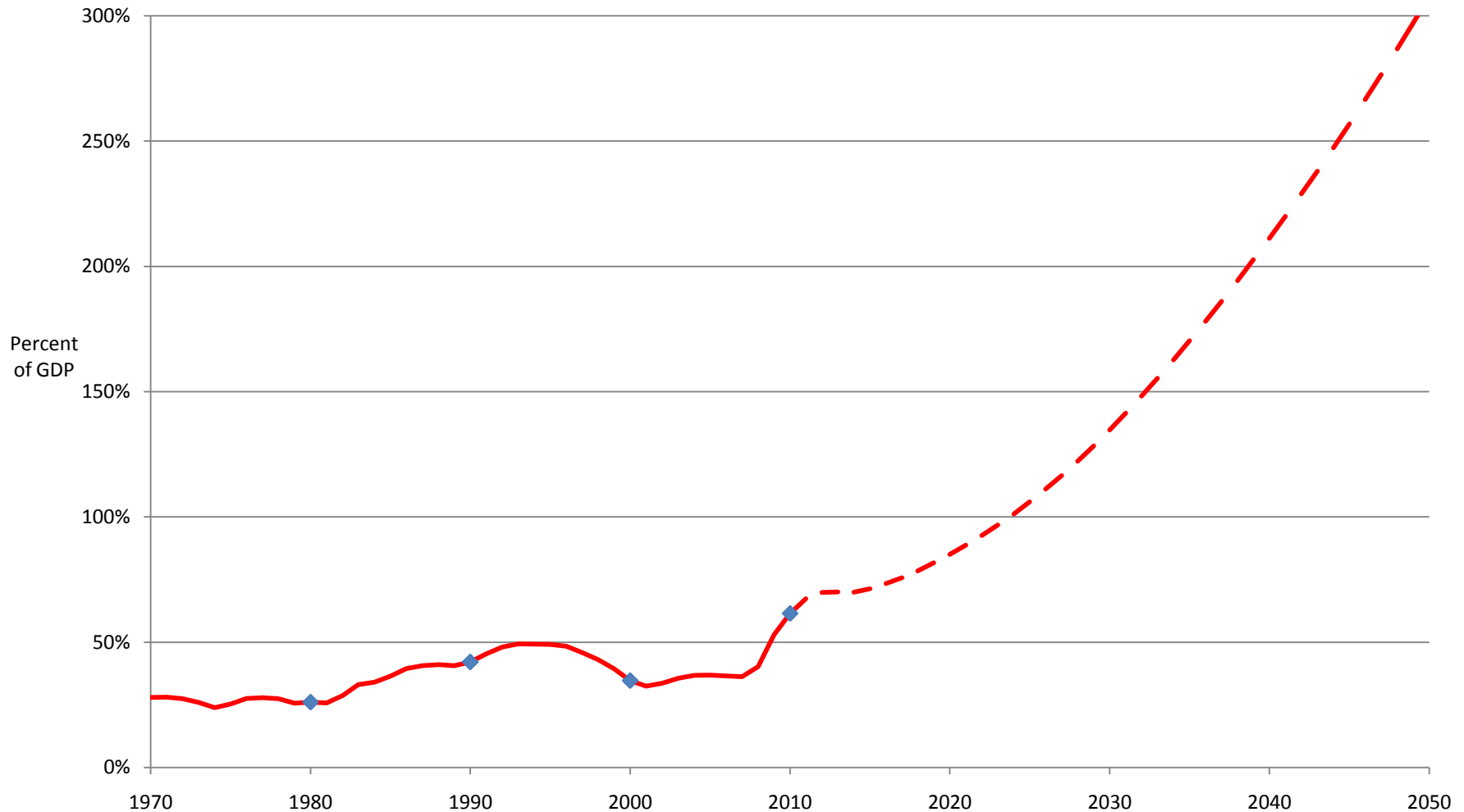

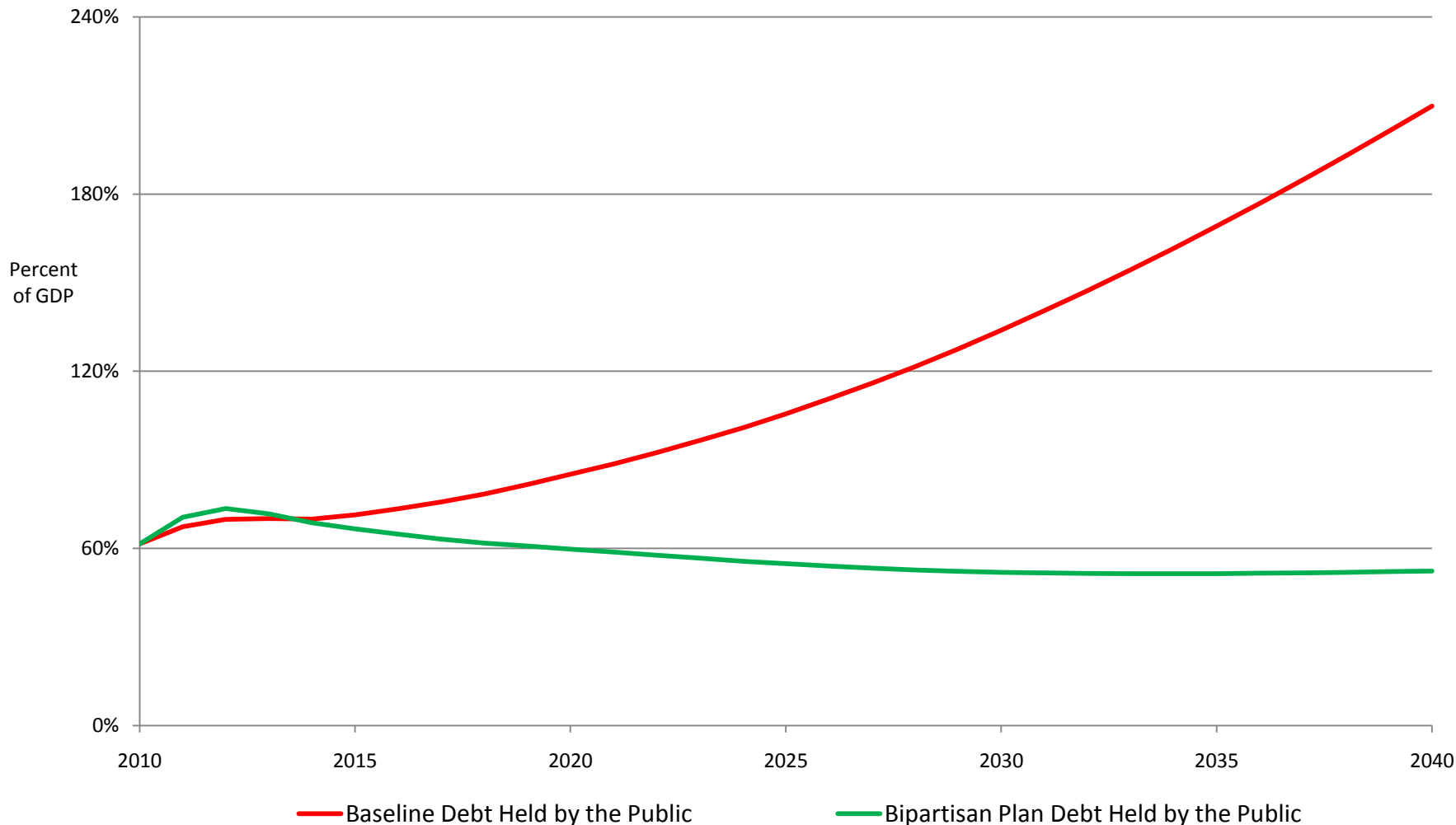

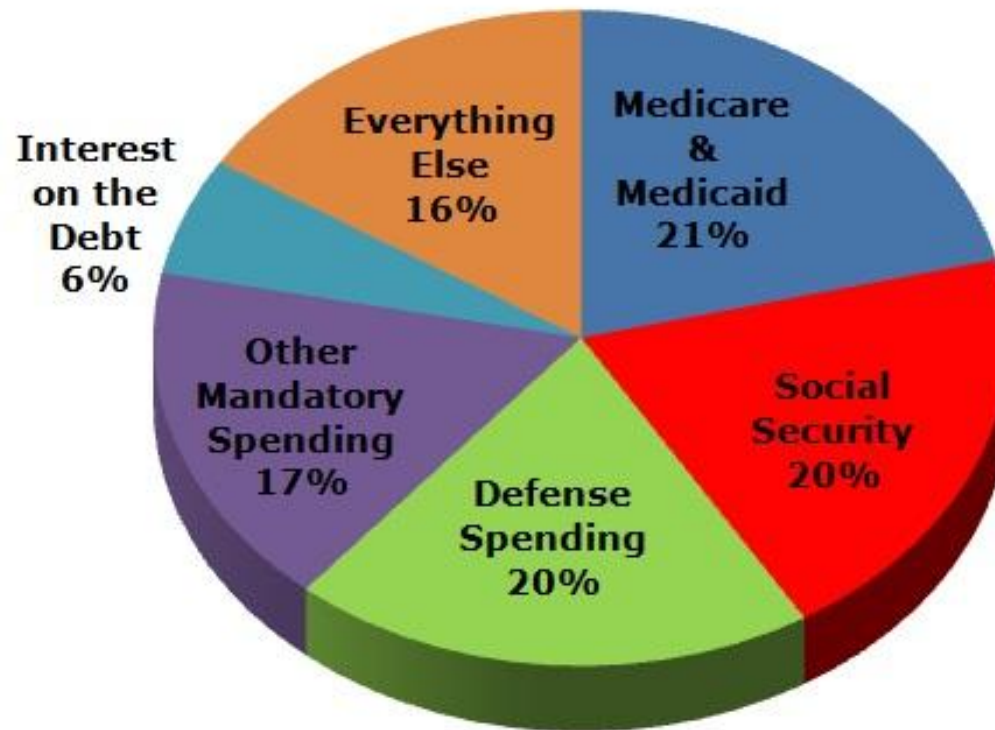

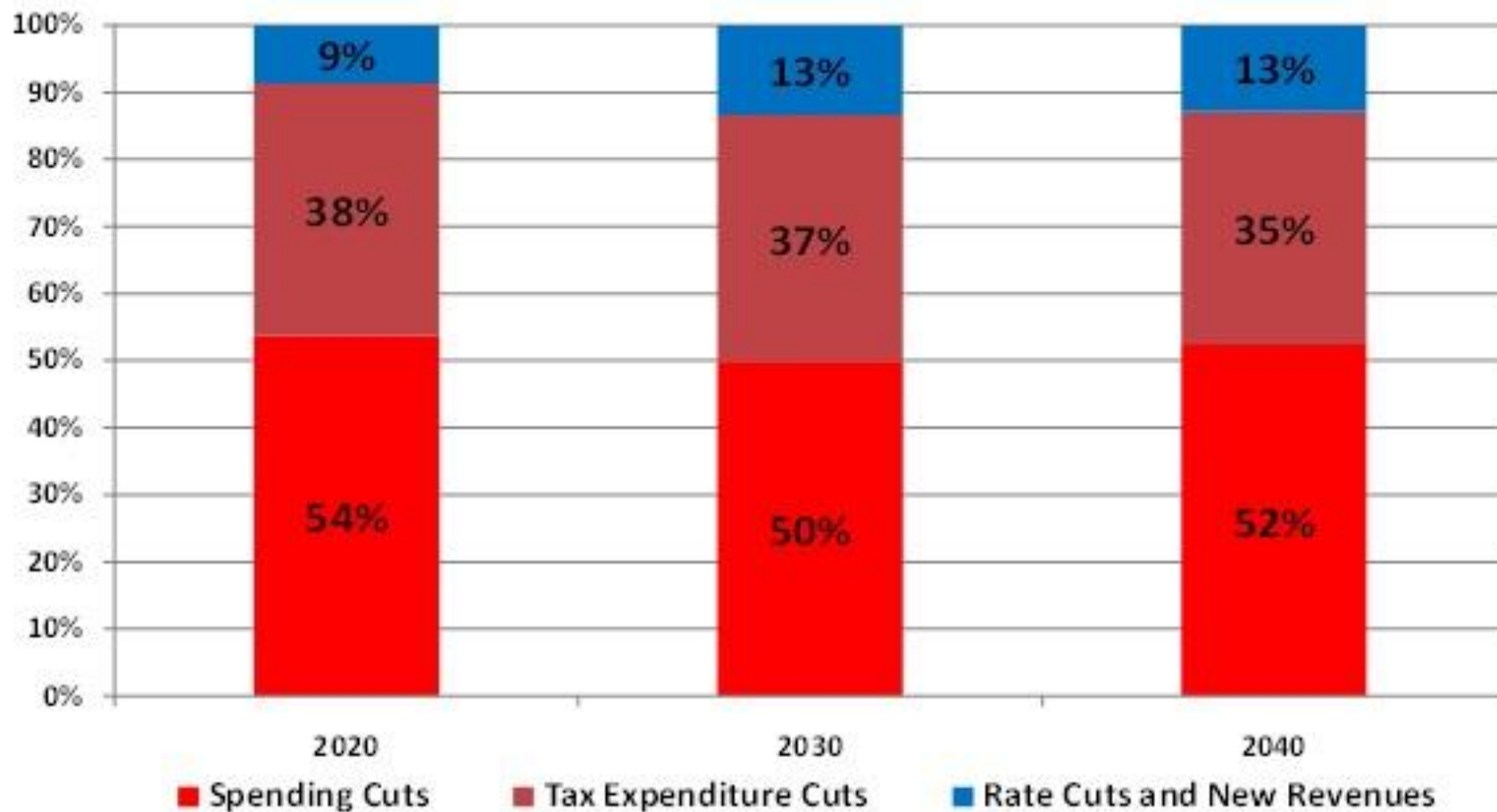


- All domestic discretionary programs that are funded annually (including education, veterans' health care, homeland security, law enforcement, etc.) make up only 16% of federal spending.

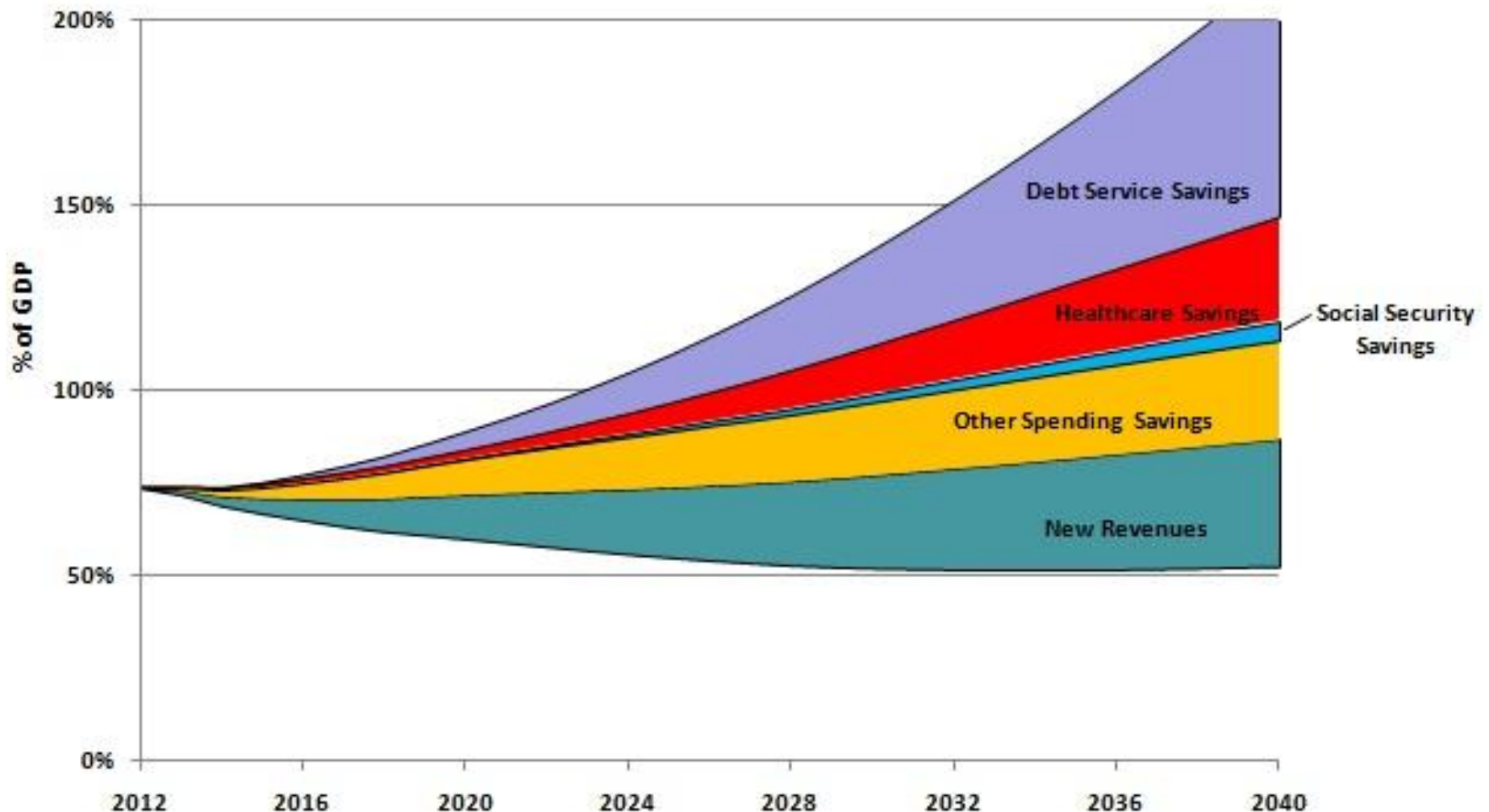

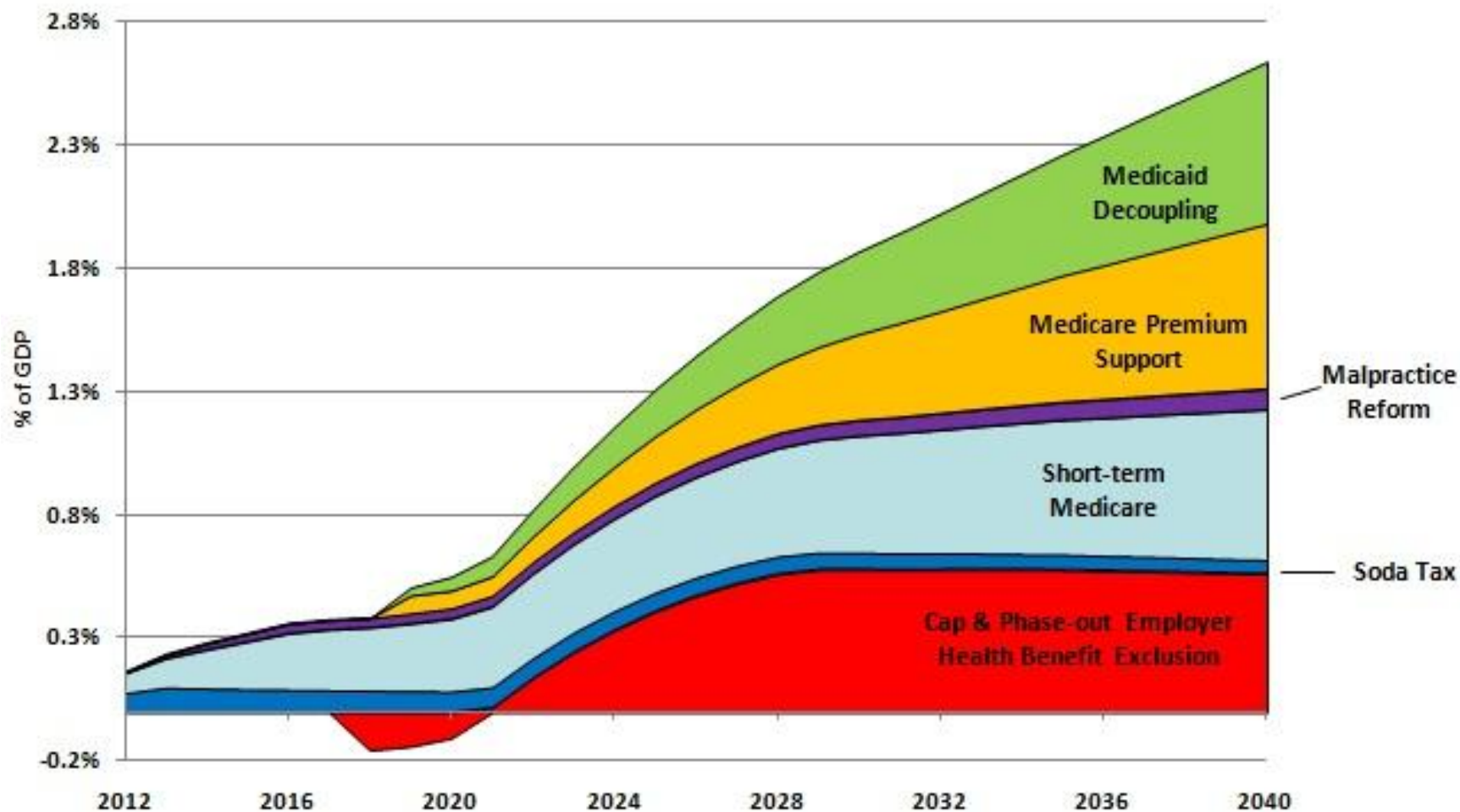
