



Nebraska's Use of CRRSA Child Care Funding

Fact Sheet | March 2021

Nebraska received **\$60 million** in supplemental CCDBG funding through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA), passed in December 2020. This is in addition to the **\$20 million** in supplemental CCDBG funding the state received in the CARES Act, passed in March 2020.

States were required to submit a plan for their use of CRRSA funds to the Department of Health and Human Services by February 26, 2021. On February 25, the state submitted a letter to HHS describing that any and all activities will be finalized once guidance for the CRRSA funds from the Administration for Children and Families is received.
