Corporate Civic Engagement Checklist

How do your company's civic engagement efforts compare with industry best practices? If there's room for your efforts to grow, BPC Democracy can help your team meet all of your civic engagement goals!

Provide employees with information from government websites about registering to vote and casting a ballot during the primary and general election season.
Where possible, provide employees with voting information specific to their state.
Connect directly with state and local election officials 9-12 months ahead of Election Day to offer resources and support.
Host civic information sessions for employees, such as 'How to Volunteer as a Poll Worker' and 'How to Protect Yourself from Misinformation.'
Provide employees with paid volunteer days to work at the polls.
Encourage peer companies to engage in civic engagement efforts; share best practices and lessons learned when possible.
Encourage lawmakers to support bipartisan election and voting legislation informed by the needs of state and local election officials.
