10 Things to Know About Colorado's Child Care Workforce

Forty-six child care workforce registries across the country collect comprehensive data on their state's workforce. This report is a first-of-its-kind snapshot of child care workforce data collected by registries across the country. This is just a small slice of the capabilities of registries, many of which collect data to even greater levels of detail.

COLORADO'S DATA

The data included here is from the Colorado Professional Development Information System as of December 21, 2023. The data includes those who work in programs participating in Colorado Shines QRIS, all staff employed in licensed centers, staff in Universal Preschool programs, and some Family Child Care Home providers. Participation in the registry for all other workforce members is voluntary. Colorado's registry has a total of 76,300 active user profiles. This report reflects 20,843 active users with verified employment working in direct care positions, inclusive of trainers and coaches. <u>Colorado's registry profile sheet</u>.




