





10 Things to Know About Illinois' Child Care Workforce


Forty-six child care workforce registries across the country collect comprehensive data on their state's workforce. This report is a first-of-its-kind snapshot of child care workforce data collected by registries across the country. This is just a small slice of the capabilities of registries, many of which collect data to even greater levels of detail.

ILLINOIS' DATA

The data included here is from the Illinois Gateways to Opportunity Registry as of January 1, 2024. The data includes those who work in non-school-based programs participating in ExceleRate Illinois and licensed child care centers, homes, and non-relative providers caring for children through the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP). Participation in the registry for all other workforce members is voluntary. Illinois' registry has a total of 113,361 active user profiles. This report reflects 74,287 active users working in direct care positions, inclusive of trainers and coaches. Illinois' registry profile sheet.


