







10 Things to Know About Minnesota's Child Care Workforce


Forty-six child care workforce registries across the country collect comprehensive data on their state's workforce. This report is a first-of-its-kind snapshot of child care workforce data collected by registries across the country. This is just a small slice of the capabilities of registries, many of which collect data to even greater levels of detail.

MINNESOTA'S DATA

The data included here is from Develop — Minnesota's Professional Development System for Early Learning and School-Age Care Professionals. as of January 1, 2023. The data includes those who work in programs participating in Parent Aware and license-exempt (FFN) providers. Participation in the registry for all other workforce members is voluntary. Minnesota's registry has a total of 49,657 active user profiles. This report reflects 24,643 active users working in direct care positions, inclusive of coaches and trainers. 


