





10 Things to Know About New Mexico's Child Care Workforce

Forty-six child care workforce registries across the country collect comprehensive data on their state's workforce. This report is a first-of-its-kind snapshot of child care workforce data collected by registries across the country. This is just a small slice of the capabilities of registries, many of which collect data to even greater levels of detail.

NEW MEXICO'S DATA

The data included here is from the New Mexico Early Childhood Education and Care Department (ECECD) as of Februrary 5, 2024. The data includes those who work in programs participating in the Competitive Pay for Professionals Grant.^{*}

*In Fiscal Year 2023, the New Mexico ECECD launched the Competitive Pay for Professionals (CPP) Grant to support \$3/hour wage increases. Child care providers who applied for CPP funding were required to provide information about their employees' wages and qualifications. The wage data included was prior to the \$3 wage increase.


