





10 Things to Know About Texas' Child Care Workforce

Forty-six child care workforce registries across the country collect comprehensive data on their state's workforce. This report is a first-of-its-kind snapshot of child care workforce data collected by registries across the country. This is just a small slice of the capabilities of registries, many of which collect data to even greater levels of detail.

TEXAS'DATA

The data included here is from the Texas Early Childhood Professional Development System and the Child Care Workforce Strategies Plan 2023–2025 as of January 3, 2023. The data includes those who work in programs participating in Texas Rising Star. Participation in the registry for all other workforce members is voluntary. Texas' registry has a total of 101,547 active user profiles. This report reflects 69,400 active users working in direct care positions, inclusive of coaches and trainers, and some data points are based on samples of the workforce.




