<sup>ii</sup> Bill does not include funding for VASH vouchers, instead proposing to shift vouchers for veterans to a new program that would be administered by the Department of Veterans Affairs—the Bridging Rental Assistance for Veteran Empowerment (BRAVE) program.

<sup>iii</sup> FY2024 and FY2025 appropriations do not differentiate between FYI and FUP.

<sup>iv</sup> President Trump’s FY26 budget request proposes consolidating Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (i.e., Housing Choice Voucher), Public Housing, Project-Based Rental Assistance, Section 811, and Section 202 programs into the State Rental Assistance Program, a formula-based block grant.

<sup>v</sup> Includes funding provided through HUD’s operating fund formula only.

<sup>vi</sup> The Continuing Resolution for FY 2025 gives the HUD Secretary the authority to repurpose funds allocated for the competitive Continuum of Care (CoC) Builds program “to provide additional amounts for the continuum of care program.”

<sup>vii</sup> The House bill references unexpended HOME funds from the nearly \$5 billion made available to the program in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2).
